We will be meeting in Hazlet, New Jersey. We explored several locations and decided that the Holiday Inn in Hazlet, NJ was the most suitable venue for this year's gathering. The hotel offers a large number of rooms and a spacious ballroom for us to hold all our events. It is less than an hour from Newark, Jersey City and the heart of New York City, and close to several eastern US cities including Philadelphia (75 min), Hartford (2.5 Hrs), Baltimore (3 Hrs), Washington DC (3.5 Hrs) and Boston (4 Hrs). 4. Performing Artistes' Information

Vidwan D. Balakrishna



Vidwan Sri. D. Balakrishna is the son and disciple of Padma Bhushan Awardee Sangeetha Kalanidhi Dr. Mysore V. Doreswamy Iyengar) who was a Veena artiste par excellence of the glorious Mysore School of Veena playing, synonymous with the great Veena Sheshanna.

He underwent rigorous training under the tutelage of his father from childhood. He has given innumerable duet performances with his father as well as critically acclaimed solo performances in India and abroad. The highlights of his artistry include his natural flair for purity of notes, rendering of ragas opulent with mellifluousness and bhava, and expertise in rhythm and

smoothness of style. He enjoys the distinction of performing as a Top Grade artist of All India Radio and brought laurels to Karnataka by performing for numerous national programs on AIR and Doordarshan. Apart from solo concerts he has played numerous jugalbandhis (duets) with eminent artistes including Sangeeta Kalanidhi M Chandrasekaran, Ustad Bahauddin Dagar, Pandit Rajeev Taranath and Pandit Debiprasad Ghosh.

Balakrishna aims at preserving and sustaining the authentic classicism of the Mysore veena tradition (a k a Mysore Baani) for the posterity. As a part of this endeavor, he is grooming disciples of whom several are currently well known AIR artistes and concert performers.

Sri D. Balakrishna has taken the flavor of Carnatic Classical Music to foreign shores. As part of his father's Pancha Veena Troupe he traveled to Russia in 1987. The year 1988 saw him winning a wide audience in Britain while accompanying his father. He participated successfully in the Pancha Veena Programme under his father's guidance at the Festival of India held in Germany in 1991. His 2002 tour of the USA was an impressive musical voyage showcasing the unique elegance of the Mysore Veena Tradition. He represented the Govt. of Karnataka in the Vishwa Kannada Sammelana held in 2006 in Washington DC. He performed at the Cleveland Thyagaraja Festival in 2010 with Sangeetha Kalanidhi T N Seshagopalan.

Sri Balakrishna is the worthy recipient of many prestigious awards and honors including:

- "Best Veena Player" from Madras Music Academy in 1979, 1991, 1996, 2006 and 2008.
- Conferred the title Ganakalshri by the Karantaka Gana Kala Parishat in 1997.
- Appointed as Asthana Vidvan of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetham in 2009
- Conferred the title "VAINIKA BRAHMA" by Naada Brahma Sangeetha Sabha, Mysore in 2013
- Conferred the title "KARNATAKA KALASHREE" by the Karnataka Sangeetha Nrithya Academy in 2014 for his contribution to preserving and propagating the excellent Mysore style of Veena technique
- Conferred the title of "Sangeetha Kala Rathna" by Bangalore Gayana Samaja in 2022

Aditi, daughter of late Sri. B.L Adishesha and Smt. Suma Shesh, was born in Bangalore. She began her journey in the art of *Bharatanatyam* from the age of six, under the tutelage of her illustrious Gurus, *Karnataka Kalasri Dr. Shridhar and Smt. Anuradha Shridhar.*

She completed her schooling from Sri Kumaran Children's Home and finished her B.Com at St. Joseph's College of Commerce. Along with her bachelor's degree, she simultaneously pursued ACCA (Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) - an international certification, and is now an affiliate.

From a young age Aditi has had a deep passion for the divine art form of dance and has actively participated in many group productions of Khechara Academy.

With the blessing of her gurus, Aditi performed her *Arangetram* on Dec 17th 2022, and with the experience gained from this first step, she went on to perform at the *Ramotsava 2023 at Basavapatna, Karnataka. Aditi looks forward to embracing Bharatanatyam as a significant part of her life and learning from the experiences it offers.

Roll Call

Meeting called to order at 10:15am.

Roll Call was held and quorum established with 25 members.

Confirmation of Minutes

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved and accepted

No committees are formed, so no committees reported.

Officers' Reports

Moved next to President's report by Prema Keshav.

Next, Ganesh Rao presented the Secretary's report.

Next, Raghunath Kanagal presented the Treasurer's report.

There were questions on the membership and how membership payments would be tracked. Plan is to record membership payment dates in the membership list.

We have filed an annual return through 2020. 2021 return extension was filed. State return does not have to be filed every year, we have received such guidance from the state. This has been audited by Mr. Sundaresan.

Q: what is the income we are receiving? Why don't we invest in T-bills?

Because it requires a minimum time invested. We may not need all the funds for working capital so we can invest some in T-bills. Current return is about \$45. Balakrishna says Temple is using investment fund to manage investments in a conservative way. Suggestion is to do the same here. Also, if income is less than \$25,000 we don't need to file. Raghunath to check. Nataraj: suggests filing for protection in any case. Filing errs on the safer side. Several others also suggest filing to avoid penalties.

Ranjini: suggests putting in partial payments for Life Members as a note in the treasurer's report. It should be noted that \$100 was received previously for life membership.

Reports will be included in Chiguru next time it is published.

Old business

Only business is membership list cleanup which will continue.

By-law cleanup is on hold for now.

New business

Discussion of dropping 501(c)(3) status to make management easier and focus on social gatherings.

Balakrishna: opposed this measure. Not sure what the future holds and it may be necessary. Also difficult to get it back in the future if we drop it. We should earmark some amount every year to match members' donations for charitable work.

Y.N. Jayaram agrees. Wants to maintain charitable focus. There is some work but there isn't much extra work and it's worth keeping the 501(c)(3). Balakrishna has done a lot of work to obtain this status and it should not be relinquished at this time.

Raghunath agrees.

Ashok Rudrapatna says that the assets must be liquidated as part of the change in status.

M.S.Nataraj: We spent a lot of effort coming up with a process to do charitable work. We should do more work now since we have the money and the facility to do charitable work. We are talking about having an organization at all or no organization.

Dathatri: money is sitting doing nothing. The Board should take the lead in distributing the money for charitable causes. I am Ok with either choice but the activities will change over the next few years. We may not need the tax exempt status if we are just organizing meetings. We would need to distribute funds to make the change.

Suresh Keshavamurthy: They have KSS in India and a Europe sangha. If we don't have an organization then we don't have meetings and purpose. It takes away from our identity. We should plan how to grow instead of cutting it down.

Uma Satyaprakash: Euro Sankethi is only social, not a charitable organization. Perhaps have a survey.

Sudarshan: perhaps need a clear set of arguments to share with members first.

Discussion that there are pros and cons and nothing can be decided now, will require recommendations and a GBM vote.

Ranjini: Consider donating to Santhosh's organization to help his organization with Ukraine charity work. This can be done with a board vote.

Santosh: We should act for all, not just Sankethis.

Ashok Rudrapatna: focus our limited resources on helping our own people first. People can contribute privately if they decide.

Discussion of donation philosophies continues. There is concern about setting a precedent, helping our people first, helping beyond our means, priorities, etc.

6. NASA's Founding President Dr. Y.N. Jayaram Passes Away

It is hard to believe that it has been over two months since the passing of NASA's founding president and everyone's beloved friend and uncle, Dr. Jayaram. He was a prominent member of several communities including NASA, the Army and the local communities in Long Island and Florida. He was the heart and soul of every NASA activity over the past four decades. The void he has left is impossible to fill but we are sure he will continue to guide us from his new abode.

Dr. Yelleshpur Narasinga Rao Jayaram passed away on March 8, 2023, at the age of 78. Dr. Jayaram was born in Mandya, Karnataka (India), did his schooling in Bengaluru, and graduated from Mysore Medical College. He emigrated to the United States in 1967 to do his residency at St. Luke's Hospital in New York City.

Dr. Jayaram subsequently worked for the Suffolk County Health Department on Long Island, NY for many years. He joined the U.S. Army Reserves (Medical Corps) in 1979 and retired as Colonel after serving for more than 30 years. He served in various military missions both in the U.S. and abroad, with international assignments in Germany, Honduras, El Salvador, and several Pacific Islands.

Dr. Jayaram was instrumental in organizing the North American Sankethi Association and served as its first president.

He is survived by his wife, Radha; his son and daughter-in-law, Jayanth & Lakshmi, and their three children: Jennani, Naveen, and Saathvik; his son, Mark; and the rest of his extended family.

The Celebration of Dr. Jayaram's Life (Vaikuṇṭha Samārādhana) was held on March 20, 2023 at The Hindu Temple of Florida in Tampa and was attended by many relatives and friends. Here are some (older) community news items that we would like to share.

Jennani Jayaram graduated from the University of Michigan Honors Program with a double-major in Mathematics and Statistics. During college she was a member of the Delta Gamma sorority and served as the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Officer. Jennani was also the Vice-President of the Reach Consulting Group and led several information technology projects with local businesses and non-profit organizations. Jennani was a violinist in the Michigan Pops Orchestra and a math, chemistry, and computer science tutor as well. During all four years at UMich, Jennani was a research assistant at a hydrology lab and developed mathematical models for predicting water levels of lakes around the world as part of broader research related to climate change and water security. Jennani's models have been adopted by the U.S.Army Corp of Engineers and the Government of Malawi, Africa, and she presented her research at the American Geophysical Union, too. Now Jennani is continuing her mathematical career and focus on the environment at Karbone in Manhattan, a company that specializes in the renewable and sustainable energy sector, and Jennani will be working in the research division for renewable energy credit markets worldwide.



Naveen Jayaram: What a year he has had in soccer! In addition to playing club soccer, Naveen also played on the state and region Olympic Development Program teams, and is the captain of his school team. Naveen also started a very popular Futsal club, too. Naveen's school soccer team's motto this year was "Make History" and they did -- they won Districts, played in the Regional Final, and were invited to the Florida Champions League for the first time in school history. The team also won the Highest GPA District Award for all winter sports. "Make History" was also a great motto for Naveen's club team. They were undefeated this season, had the best defensive record in the league, won the Florida Conference for the first time in club history for any age group, and advanced to the National Championships in San Diego, too.



Jathin Rao graduated from Needham High School and earned the Don Brock Award for Excellence in Mathematics. He will attend college at McGill University in Montreal, Canada in the Fall.
