

### 8. In Memoriam

Sandya Magge October 14, 1977 – February 24, 2024









It is with heavy hearts that we bid farewell to Sandya Magge, of Manhattan Beach, CA, who passed away on February 24, 2024, at the age of 46 after a long battle with cancer. Sandya's life was a testament to strength, resilience, and unwavering dedication to her family, friends, and passions.

Born on October 14, 1977, to Tandav and Susheela Magge in Murrysville, PA, Sandya brought joy and warmth into the lives of all who knew her. She met her best friend and husband, Ketan Jhaveri, in 2002, whom she married on May 12, 2007. She was a beacon of light, radiating positivity wherever she went. Her infectious laughter and genuine smile lit up any room she entered, leaving an indelible mark on those fortunate enough to have crossed paths with her.

Sandya's commitment to her loved ones was unparalleled. As a devoted spouse, parent, sibling, and friend, she poured boundless energy and support into every relationship she cherished. Her compassionate nature knew no bounds, and she always went above and beyond to ensure the happiness and well-being of those around her. She brought a positive spirit to many NASA Meetings, especially in the 90's, where she participated in youth discussions, basketball competitions, and General Body Meetings.

Professionally, Sandya held a Bachelor's Degree from the University of Pennsylvania, a Master's Degree in Public Health from the Johns Hopkins School of Public Health, and a Master's Degree in Business Administration from Columbia University. She built a successful career as an executive leader in marketing and sales of digital products at companies such as American Express, Samsung, and Visa. Her strategic vision, optimism, and leadership were admired by colleagues and peers alike. She approached every task with enthusiasm and determination, and was considered a team builder and mentor.

In addition to her profound impact on the lives of others, Sandya was a passionate advocate for women and girls. During her career in multiple corporate entities, she built her leadership as a strong advocate for gender equality and justice in the workplace, and pivoted her career to orient more directly on corporate diversity, equity, and inclusion initiatives.

Beyond her professional endeavors, Sandya had a voracious love of life. She loved to travel with her family, and moved from Brooklyn, NY to Manhattan Beach, CA to realize her dream of living by the ocean with sunshine and palm trees with her husband and three beautiful children. Sandya embraced life with a sense of adventure and gratitude that inspired all who knew her.

Sandya is survived by her mother, Susheela Magge, siblings Seetha Chandra and Keshav Magge, husband Ketan Jhaveri, and children Lila (11 yrs), Veda (11 yrs), and Zane (6 yrs).

### <u>Padma Shri Athi Vishisht Seva Medalist Wing Commander K. Ramachandra Rao</u> Feb 24, 1922 – Mar 16, 2024

Wing Commander Keshavamurthy Ramachandra Rao was commissioned in the Technical Signals Branch of the Indian Air Force in January 1950. He attended a number of specialist and staff courses in India and abroad, in which his performance was of the highest order. He was awarded the Woods of Colchester Prize in 1962 for standing first in his course at the College of Aeronautics, Cranfield (UK), thus bringing credit to the Air Force and the nation.

After holding a wide variety of appointments at units, Repair Depots, and Air Headquarters, Wing Commander Rao joined the Indian Space Research Organization in May 1965 where he was Director of the Experimental Satellite Communication Earth Station, (ESCES), Ahmedabad. In addition to his responsibilities as ESCES Director, he was entrusted with the responsibility of setting up the Arvi Satellite Communication Earth Station for the Department of Communication. Wing Commander Rao had a flair for tackling projects involving new technology and the challenging task of setting up the Arvi Station provided him an opportunity to utilize his technical knowledge, professional skill, creative mind, and sound and thorough organizing ability. In setting up the Arvi Station, Wing Commander Rao accomplished a very important task. The most important single unit made for the first time in India, namely a large 97 ft. steerable antenna involving sophisticated engineering, was completed in record time and met and, in some particulars, exceeded, all technical performance requirements. His pioneering work put India on the space communication map and led to his receipt of the Padma Shri Award by the Government of India.

He immigrated to the United States with his wife, Lakshmi, to be closer to his daughters, Aruna and Usha, who had pursued their higher education and were living in New Jersey. At the young age of 70, he went to Idaho in pursuit of a PhD to fulfill a personal goal. Unfortunately, family obligations called him back to New Jersey, where he continued to make an impact on his community by teaching mathematics and nurturing a love of learning in his grandchildren.

K. Ramachandra Rao is survived by his brother, K. Sundaresan, daughters, Aruna Rao and Usha Rao, grandchildren Vikram and Beena Premkumar, Priya and Praveen Srinivasan, and great-grandchildren Jackson and Anika Varricchio.
