### 3. Sneak Peek: A few of our Featured Artists

We are so excited to share more information about the artists for two of our featured programs for the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration! Please join us in person to welcome the following artists to the NASA stage:



**Smt. Sridevi Koushik** began learning Carnatic Music at the age of six from her mother, Smt. Jyothi Ramesh. After eight years of tutelage under Vid. Rama Rao, she received advanced training from Ganakalabhushana Vid. R. K. Padmanabha. She has performed in several Sabhas in South India and in the US. Her programs have also been broadcast in the All India Radio & the Bay Area community TV channels. She lives with her family in the San Francisco Bay Area.



**Shreyas Bharadwaj** began his flute journey at age eight under the tutelage of Guru Shri Mohan Rangan, disciple of Sangeetha Kalaratna Professor H. V. Krishnamurthy, principal of Vijaya College of Music, Bengaluru. Shreyas is deeply influenced by the style and rendering of flute maestro Dr. N. Ramani. Apart from winning first prizes in various competitions like Cleveland Thyagaraja Aradhana, Bay Area Kala Aradhana, etc. in multiple categories and multiple years in a row, Shreyas was named the best instrumentalist of North America in the finals of Sangeetha Samrat 2015 and was conferred “Venuganam Janardhana Iyer Child Artist Award” by Neelakanta Sivan Cultural Academy (NSCA), Chennai in 2016. Shreyas has performed across North America, Bengaluru and Chennai. His most recent performance was a duet with Vid. Shri Thiagarajan Ramani, accompanied by Dr. D. Badri Narayanan (violin) and Vid. Mannargudi A. Easwaran (mridangam) at Cleveland Thyagaraja Festival, 2024. Shreyas is a first year PhD student at MIT in the department of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science.



**Tejas Bharadwaj** started learning violin under the tutelage of Smt. Anuradha Srudhar, daughter and disciple of Vidushi Lalgudi Srimathi Brahmanandam. Since 2016, he has been undergoing training under Vidwan Shri B.V. Raghavendra Rao, senior disciple of Sangeetha Kalanidhi Shri T. N. Krishnan. Tejas, an ardent listener of vocal and violin stalwarts from yesteryears, tries to imbibe the gayaki style to emphasize the underlying sahityam or lyrics of the compositions. Tejas has won several first prizes in krithi, alapana and swara categories in violin at Cleveland Thyagaraja Aradhana, and in 2018 he was also named the winner of Pallavi (violin) competition. Tejas regularly accompanies artists around the US and was invited to perform at the Narada Gana Sabha youth talent promotion event 2019 (Chennai). In the same year, he also had the honor of accompanying whistle wizard Vidwan Siva Prasad at Shiva-Vishnu temple, Livermore, CA. Tejas is a sophomore at UCLA studying Electrical and Computer Engineering.



**Varchas Bharadwaj** was attracted to layam and percussion after watching a Tala Vadya Kutcheri, an ensemble of percussion instruments. Mesmerized and inspired by the performance, soon Varchas started learning mridangam under Guru Shri Shriram Brahmanandam, disciple of Vidwan Shri Rajappa Iyer of Kumbhakonam. Guru Shriram instilled in him a solid foundation, especially with reference to fingering techniques, the fulcrum of this art. Since 2016, Varchas has been studying under Vidwan Trivandrum Balaji, a disciple of the legendary percussionist Sangeetha Kalanidhi Shri Palghat Raghu. Varchas has won the first prize at the prestigious Cleveland Thyagaraja Festival, several years in multiple categories. He has also won first prizes at Bay Area Kala Aradhana and Sangeeth Samrat competition conducted by Sankara TV and Abayam creations. Varchas regularly accompanies artists across North America and in India. Varchas, a sophomore at UCLA, studies Computational Biology.
